
Happy Holidays!

For those that came to the meet the teacher meetings we explained that homework has changed for next year with more emphasis on basic skills relevant to the child's age and stage and that we have slightly changed the behaviour reward system to emphasise the positive so if your child comes home saying they have had 10 smileys this week you will know they have had lots of positives.

Medical Appointments
