

Art club after school from Reception—Year 6 children

During assemblies children are shown the work of a focus artist each term to be able to discuss and find out about.

Whole school art projects and curriculum days are used to bring art to life and link art to other areas of the curriculum. Giving the children chance to see their work alongside others and on a large scale.

Bi- annually the school holds an art exhibition where the art work of all children is displayed for friends and family to come and view and the art work can be purchased.

Children from Reception to Year 6 are given the opportunity to explore different mediums to create and respond to art work. Using sketch books, paper, card, oil pastels, chalk, charcoal, acrylic/watercolour/oil paints, clay, modroc, junk modelling, sewing, ICT and many more. Both in 2D and 3D forms.

All children from Reception to Year 6 are taught through designated art lessons as well as through cross-curricular links.

The creative approach to the Curriculum allows children to react, research, respond and reflect. Broadening their knowledge of a variety of artists and art techniques.
