The Reading VIPERS are embedded in Year 1-6 to teach Reading approach

Reading for Pleasure time allows children to hear an age appropriate novel being read to them in order to share a passion for reading and to widen their vocabulary for writing.

Grammar objectives are taught and consolidated throughout writing lessons.

Reading enrichment activities occur throughout the year from celebrating World Book Day to learning about notable authors and exploring books across the whole school.

What does it look like?

Staff foster a love for reading and are happy to recommend books for children.

Pupils are invited to attend book clubs.

RWI phonics programme is taught in KS1

Reading 'Top Picks' boxes allow pupils to borrow recommended reads for their age group. They can then present a review for their peers.

Reading buddy activities are well-established in EYFS, KS1 and Year 3. Pupils from Year 5 and 6 are trained to be 'Buddy Resders'
