

Languages after school club is available for pupils from Year 3—Year 6 children

During singing assembly KS1 and KS2 learn French vocabulary through songs.

The whole school hold celebrations on diversity and curriculum days bi-annually such as 'Around the World days' or 'French Cuisine Taster days.'

Children are given the opportunity to learn about different countries and cultures where our chosen school language is spoken..

In KS2 children have the opportunity to communicate with our link school in France and share oral and written communication to extend their language skills.

Language Angels is used to teach French to all children from Year 3 to Year 6.

This scheme follows the National Curriculum and allows children to practise listening to, speaking, and writing in French.

What does it look like?



Children are given the opportunity to practise speaking French through songs and role play. Such as cafes, travel agents, etc.

Children are exposed to languages from KS1 so that we weave the speaking and listening elements of languages into the wider curriculum to create confident linguists in KS2. This is done through salutations at the beginning and middle of the day, including registers. Count downs and praise and rewards given in class ('tre bien'). Also through songs sang within the classroom and numbers and colours within PE.
